NEW PORTS OF CALL

KUMAMOTO (YATSUSHIRO), IAPAN

In a land of fairy-tale castles, Kumamoto is home to one of Japan's three greatest. After recovering from siege and fire in 1877, Kumamoto Castle sustained its greatest damage in the earthquake of 2016 - ironic given the castle is known for its dark obsidian color resembling Japan's volcanic landscape. Repairs are ongoing but in some ways further emphasize the castle's astounding scale. In places where the massive, once impenetrable walls have crumbled, their graceful curves are being rebuilt like a puzzle, stone by stone. Kato Shrine gives you an excellent view of the elegant black towers, turrets and walls that remain intact. While the castle recalls a violent history, it is enveloped by serene natural beauty. A network of underground springs has made Kumamoto a lush oasis of verdant parks and natural lakes. Reputed for its pristine nature, the city boasts drinking water so clean it will purify your soul.

MARÉ ISLAND, NEW CALEDONIA

Given its proximity to other popular islands of New Caledonia, it is truly remarkable that Maré Island remains so untouched by the outside world. Ancient tectonic forces lifted this coral atoll above the sea, creating a striking landscape where lush forests suddenly plummet into limestone caves encircling natural freshwater pools. Swaying palms and feathery pines adorn ragged cliffs that soar into the air and then plunge into grottoes and hidden lagoons. White swaths of sand lie along waters that appear the brightest shade of turquoise from a distance, but upon approach become so clear as to almost disappear. In this pristine paradise, the arrival of a ship is a major event, and the island's small population will welcome you with traditional songs and impromptu markets offering local wares. Embrace their friendliness and learn where to find the most scenic spots on the island.



MIYAZAKI (ABURATSU), IAPAN

A seaside resort town, Miyazaki enjoys more sunshine than any other Japanese city. Those who love sand and surf appreciate the miles of coastline and mild climate that create excellent beachgoing and surfing conditions. If you prefer the mountains, verdant ranges rise inland, where you might plan a day trip to the hot springs of Kirishima, the gorge of Takachiho or the Aya Teruha pedestrian bridge suspended nearly 500 feet above a forested valley. Natural wonders are also found in the unique geology of peaceful Aoshima Island and in shrines to ancient gods tucked in seaside caves and scenic parklands. The city has fascinating museums and abundant shopping. Visit a distillery to learn the process of making shochu, a popular Japanese spirit distilled from many different sources, such as sweet potatoes, rice or barley.

MONTEREY, CALIFORNIA

The rugged cliffs, lush cypress and cerulean waters of the Monterey Peninsula are so stunningly beautiful that one of the area's most famous attractions is simply a 17-mile drive along the coast. Perched on these scenic shores, the town of Monterey has long inspired artists and authors alike. Recalling the city's heyday as a sardine canning capital, Ocean View Boulevard was renamed Cannery Row after John Steinbeck's novel by that name immortalized the street. Now the fishing shacks along the waterfront have been refurbished into antique shops and restaurants, and one former cannery house is a world-renowned aquarium. Spend the day picking the best clam chowder on Fisherman's Wharf, but you should also have a salad. The cold waters of the offshore Blue Grand Canyon, twice the depth of its namesake, create a uniquely temperate climate that harvests the freshest produce in the country, as well as distinctive wines.



OARAL, JAPAN

Known for long stretches of pristine beach, a large aquarium and an oceanfront shrine, the seaside town of Oarai entices you with all things coastal. Try fresh seafood, such as a rice bowl with raw sardines served with grated ginger and soy sauce. Caught just offshore, the young sardines must be eaten the same day as they are caught, and thus they draw gourmets from around Japan to Oarai. A short jaunt inland to Mito would also be worthwhile, as it is home to one of Japan's three great gardens, Kairakuen. Opened in 1842 by the local lord Tokugawa Nariaki, the garden is famous for its more than 3,000 plum trees, which herald the arrival of spring when they bloom from late February through March.

OSAKA, JAPAN

Prior to the 8th century, the capital of Japan moved with each new emperor and Osaka was one of those earliest capitals. Osaka then grew into a commercial center of the rice trade and became known as "the nation's kitchen," a moniker now applied because of the city's reputation for cuisine so good that, as the saying goes, people go broke buying it. A vibrant arts culture also developed in the 17th century, including the famous kabuki and bunraku theaters that can still be seen today. Devastated during World War II, Osaka reemerged as a maze of bridges and skyscrapers flanking a moated castle that stands in the city center as a reminder of a regal past. The skyline gains further allure from the illumination of several Ferris wheels, unique status symbols of modern Japanese cities.

PETROPAVLOVSK-KAMCHATSKY, RUSSIA

Accessible only by air or sea, the remote city of Petropavlovsk-Kamchatsky is surrounded by what UNESCO describes as "one of the most outstanding volcanic regions in the world." The snowcapped peaks of Koryak and Avacha loom directly behind the city, and the terrain is so mountainous that one cannot see the horizon from any point in town. Admire one of Russia's most majestic landscapes from any number of vantage points: a cruise through the bay, an ATV excursion to the base of an active volcano, a challenging summit hike or a helicopter ride. While rugged natural beauty may be the biggest draw, the town also holds historical significance as a military outpost and the region's capital. Some worthwhile museums and monuments combine to tell the story of Russia's most easterly city, from its founding by Vitus Bering through the Crimean War and the Soviet era.

PHILLIP ISLAND (RHYLL), AUSTRALIA

Phillip Island boasts wide sandy beaches, spectacular coastal scenery, excellent surfing and a world-famous Grand Prix circuit. However, its biggest attraction measures about one foot tall and weighs just two or three pounds. The island is home to thousands of little penguins, endearing not only as the smallest penguins on the planet but also for their unique blue coloring. Each day as the sun sets, the tiny birds return from a long day of fishing at sea and waddle up the beaches to the safety of their burrows. Affectionately known as the Penguin Parade, this magical scene has enchanted visitors since 1920. An array of wildlife beyond the penguins also can be observed here, including whales, koalas and Australia's largest fur seal colony. Those not fond of furry friends might visit the National Vietnam Veterans Museum, take a stroll on the seaside boardwalk, or check out a local brewery or winery.

SAN SEBASTIÁN DE LA GOMERA, CANARY ISLANDS

To experience the quieter side of the Canaries untouched by the tourist trade, call on the unspoiled island of La Gomera. Here the only things more ancient than the cultural traditions are the native laurel forests that blanket the volcanic peaks rising into the clouds. Plunging ravines disappear into a lush green carpet fed by gurgling streams, and craggy outcrops rise into an ever-present shroud of mist that nurtures the luxuriant highlands, lending a magical aura. So isolating was this rugged terrain that native inhabitants developed a language of whistling to communicate across the miles. The language is preserved today, so ask for a demonstration in a local restaurant in San Sebastián de la Gomera, the coastal town that descends from the hills to the black sand beaches below. The town also celebrates less ancient history, as this was the final stop of Christopher Columbus before he sailed for the Americas.

SANTA BARBARA, CALIFORNIA

Known as the American Riviera, the enchanting town of Santa Barbara is nestled between the picturesque coastline of its southern shores and the verdant Santa Ynez Mountains rising steeply to the north. The warm sunshine of a Mediterranean climate illuminates the red-tiled roofs and adobe façades of the town's Spanish Colonial architecture, including the grand Old Mission founded by the first Spanish settlers in the 18th century. Santa Barbara may be best enjoyed with a pleasant stroll, be it through Shoreline Park, along Stearns Wharf or down hip State Street. Renowned art and history museums, winetasting rooms, seaside cafés and charming boutiques provide endless entertainment in town, while just over the mountains in the fertile Santa Ynez Valley, you can tour several award-winning wineries.

ALBANY, AUSTRALIA

Western Australia's oldest colonial settlement, Albany holds not only great historical significance but also immense natural beauty. Founded in 1826 as a British military outpost, the town evolved into a provisioning port for ships, a departure point for Australian troops bound for World War I, and eventually a base for the whaling industry. History buffs will be intrigued by sites such as the Anglican church, town hall, restored gaol and a one-of-a-kind whaling station museum, while the dramatic scenery of the rugged coastline will astound anyone fortunate enough to sail into Princess Royal Harbour. Known as Ataturk Entrance, the channel accessing the harbor from King George Sound is quite narrow, with forested peaks rising on either side from the rocky shores and sweeping white beaches.

AOMORI, JAPAN

Each change of season brings fresh new beauty to the coastal city of Aomori. The blush of cherry blossoms greets you in spring, while in winter the forests of the surrounding mountains are so heavily laden with snow that the trees appear to be giant white beasts. The port is dominated by Aomori Bay Bridge, offering great views of both the city and the harbor and mirroring the striking triangular design of the Aomori Prefecture Tourist Center. The skyline's contemporary angles result from the city's destruction during World War II and rebuilding thereafter, but Aomori also celebrates ancient societies that settled here millennia ago. You'll be reminded of this prehistoric past at the 21st-century museum of modern art, as its architecture pays homage to the nearby excavations of ancient ruins. After exploring, relax at the caldera lakes and natural hot springs in the lush countryside.

DUTCH HARBOR, ALASKA

Located on Amaknak Island and linked via bridge to Unalaska Island, Dutch Harbor is a place of historical significance, stunning natural beauty and resilient people. Walk in the footsteps of the indigenous Aleut, or Unangan, people by following trails established thousands of years ago. The paths take you through swaths of wildflowers dotting green valleys from which rise volcanic peaks surrounded by the sea, a windswept land so pristine you will forget that signs of civilization are nearby. Even so, Russian fur traders and American armed forces did make their marks here. The U.S. established a naval base in 1940. and Dutch Harbor became a theater for World War II. While intriguing museums recall a turbulent past, today Dutch Harbor embraces the peaceful nature of its scenic surroundings and thrives as a fishing "village" that brings in the country's largest catch.

HAKODATE, JAPAN

In 1854 Hakodate became Japan's first port to open to foreign trade as the country's era of isolationism came to an end. The resulting influx of traders and merchants from Russia, China and Western countries imprinted the city with a mélange of cultural styles that now distinguish Hakodate's unique atmosphere. Star-shaped Goryokaku Fort was designed in the European style – even as its purpose was to defend Japan from foreign imperialism - and is now flanked by thousands of native cherry trees. The Russian Orthodox Church stands just blocks from the Chinese Memorial Hall, and nearby you'll find traditional Japanese markets selling the signature Hakodate shio ramen, a salty noodle dish that is the city's specialty. Beef lovers can try the famously flavorful Hakodate Onuma beef, while overlooking scenic Lake Onuma.
